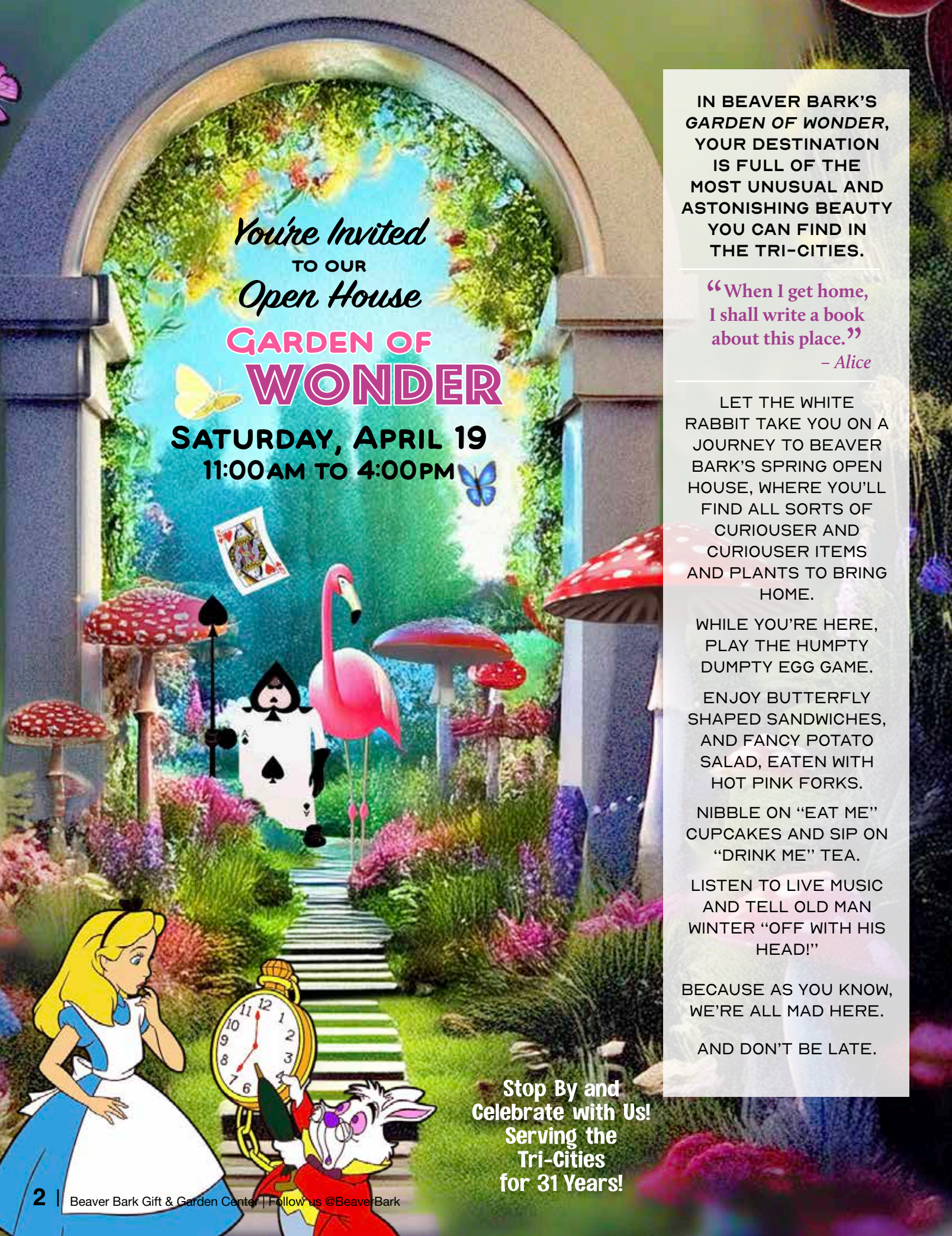

NEW FOR 2025!

The Monarch Magic Ageratum!

Also known as Flossflower and native to Mexico, this pretty tough low maintenance annual blooms continually in our Tri-Cities full sun summers, even into November.

The fluffy bright lavender-blue flowers resemble a snowflake, which gives it such a unique look, making it a showstopper in garden design.

New breeding for 2025 focuses on it as one of the Monarch butterfly's food sources, calling it *Monarch Magic*. The Monarch's life cycle begins in Mexico, where they can migrate thousands of miles to reach southern Canada. This migration is one of the greatest phenomena in the natural world. Monarchs know the direction to migrate even though the individuals that migrate have never made this journey before. They follow their internal compass in spring and fall, and their bright orange wings communicate to predators that they are poisonous and to attack at their own risk!

As a butterfly favorite, this Ageratum is an excellent choice for baskets or containers with its spreading and trailing habit.

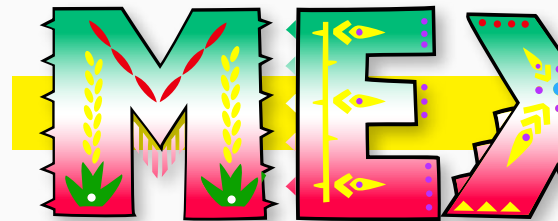
Much like Lantana, Ageratum is super heat-tolerant. It pairs well with Passion Fruit Lantana and Black and Bloom Salvia, providing a pollinator's feast. They will certainly appreciate your efforts to provide much-needed food sources while you enjoy their visits!

Grown right here in our own greenhouses, these summertime favorites will be ready early May, and it doesn't get any more local than that!



Maracas are percussion instruments made from dried gourds or wood, filled with seeds or beads, hand-painted with colorful designs.

Mexico is one of the richest botanical regions in the world, with a vast array of plant species, both rare and familiar. In fact, many of our favorite flowers have origins as wildflowers in the Mexican landscape, and the list is so very long!

Cosmos, Ageratum, Canna, Dahlia, Salvia, and Glories are among the flowers that have been brought south of the border. Many have traditional uses as medicines, or in celebrations like Día de los Muertos.

The Mexican flag features a golden eagle perched on a prickly pear cactus, devouring a snake, symbolizing an Aztec legend about the founding of Tenochtitlán and representing strength, independence, and heritage.



Mexico's Sweet Chocolate Cosmos

Native to the heart of Mexico, the Chocolate Cosmos isn't just a flower; it's a piece of history. With its deep, velvety petals and rich cocoa scent, it's a symphony of color and beauty. AUST



Last year, Todd and I went “Down Under” and discovered some unusual flora and fauna. It was quite an adventure, and here are some highlights:

Native to southwestern Australia, I was so excited when I found *Kangaroo Paws* growing wild while visiting the city of Adelaide. This whimsical plant gets its name from the tubular, velvety flowers whose clusters resemble... you guessed it, a kangaroo’s curved paws.

These are grown commercially for cut flower markets in Australia, Israel, Japan and the U.S., because they’re an excellent, long-lasting choice in flower arrangements. Depending on the variety, these fuzzy flowers can be yellow, red, green, orange, and even blue.

Their botanical name is as unusual as this fun-shaped plant with the cute name: *Anigozanthos!* *Kangaroo Paws* do best in a sunny spot with well-drained soil, avoiding standing water. Though they need to be treated as an annual here in the Tri-Cities, they make a fun Thriller in containers, with their texture and vibrant colors. They invite hummingbirds and other pollinators to stop by.

The next discovery we made on our journey through the wondrous Australian countryside is the Eucalyptus.

Can you imagine eating the same thing every single day of your life? There are at least several thousand different Eucalyptus species native to Australia. However, the cute and cuddly-looking Koala eat the leaves of only a few varieties of this low nutrition, toxin-ridden tree, but it is their main food source, consuming two pounds a day from their



perches up high in these trees.

Koalas absorb water from the leaves, so they rarely need to drink. But they do need to sleep in order to digest those toxins from the Eucalyptus leaves, and sleep they do best... up to twenty hours a day!

The Eucalyptus that we’re growing are *Silver Dollar* and *Baby Blue*, and are not tasty to Koalas. They are however, very popular as fresh-cut foliage in bouquets and arrangements, where the crisp and spicy fragrance of the *Silver Dollar’s* leaves appear to be strung along the stems.

Eucalyptus is great during winter months as a house plant, but prefers additional light, and will grow best in full sun outside when it warms up.

Even further along on our journey we found *Agapanthus*, (also called *Lily of the Nile*). I’ve never seen so many *Agapanthus* in my entire life until Australia. I assumed they were native, but learned Southern Africa wins the prize for this lovely species. They thrive in hot climates, and are quite showy.

There are only a few perennial varieties of *Agapanthus* that come back each year here in the Tri-Cities. A drought-tolerant summer bloomer with grass-like leaves, its flowers rise above the grassy foliage, typically exploding in July, like fireworks. With their vibrant summer colors, they make lovely mass plantings in borders.

The varieties we’re offering will be ready in May:

- *Midnight Blue* (Hardy to Zone 6)
- *Purple Potion* (Hardy to Zone 7)
- *Bridal Veil* (Hardy to Zone 7)

ORANGEOLA LAUCELEAF JAPANESE MAPLE

Orangeola has bright red-orange new growth that continues on the long cascading shoots, even as the maturing foliage fades to a deep reddish green in summer. Fall color is a brilliant orange-red. It's strongly pendulous branches produce a superb spreading habit and will make a colorful centerpiece for your garden.
Size: 4 ft. tall and 3 ft. wide in 10 years.

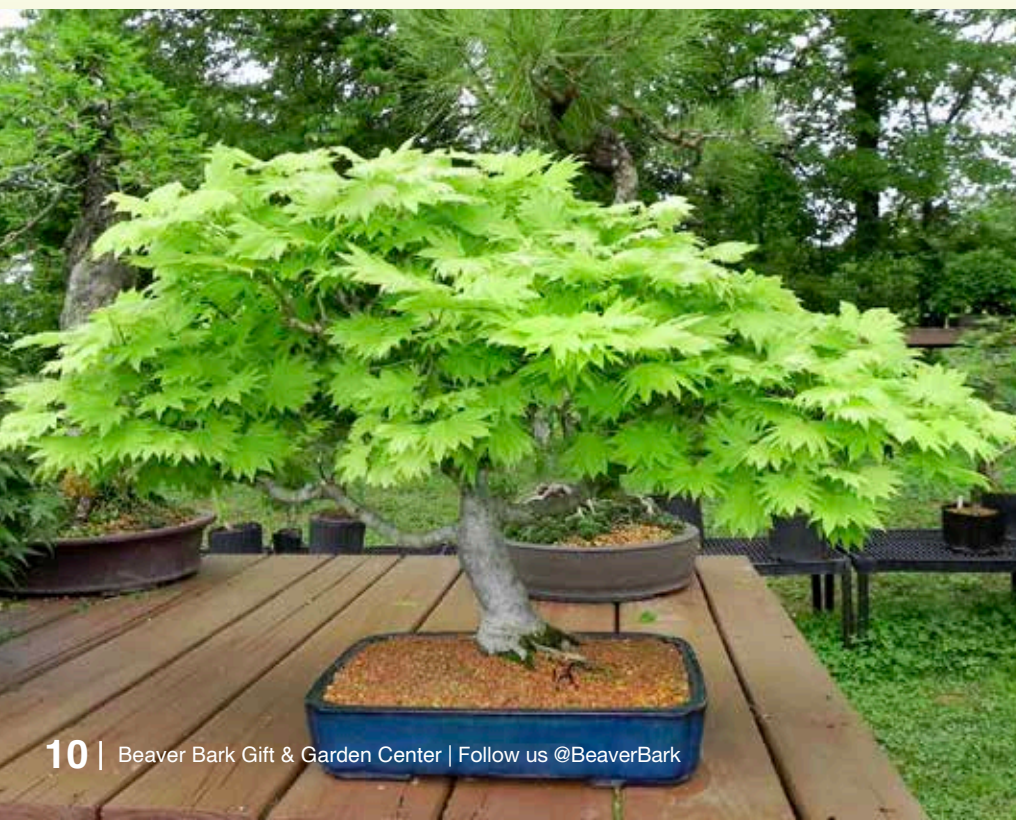
Originating as a method of preserving fish with fermented rice, to its evolution into a globally beloved culinary art, sushi is a timeless fusion of tradition, freshness, and innovation.

GOLDEN FULL MOON JAPANESE MAPLE

Aureum is highly valued for its beautifully shaped leaves. Every spring, this small, slow-growing, garden tree displays outstanding, glowing color. Yellow-green leaves brighten shadier spots throughout the summer before showing off its orange and red hues in fall. Makes an excellent bonsai, as you can see by the image below.
Size: 8 ft. tall and 7 ft. wide in 10 years.

MIKAWA YATSUBUSA JAPANESE MAPLE

The leaves of the multi-branched, compact *Mikawa Yatsubusa* overlap one another like shingles on a roof, producing a dense, rounded shape. The foliage is light yellow-green with red tips and margins, turning brilliant fiery red, and darker red leaves create a striking contrast.
Size: 5 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide in 10 years.

Rooted in ancient tradition, bonsai trees originated in China over a thousand years ago before being refined in Japan into a revered art form, symbolizing patience, harmony, and the beauty of nature in miniature form.



CORAL BARK JAPANESE MAPLE

Sango Kaku is sought after for its flaming, coral-red bark that stands out against drifts of snow in winter. Its leaves emerge in spring with a flush of bright, yellow-orange, and shift to a soft green for summer, providing a vivid contrast to the glowing, coral bark. Its bright golden fall color adds another flashy effect to its yearly show.

Size: 15-18 ft. tall and 8-10 ft. wide in 10 years.

BUTTERFLY JAPANESE MAPLE

Acer palmatum Butterfly is a small yet gorgeous vase-shaped tree with dainty, variegated green and white leaves, edged with a light blush of pink. In the fall, these creamy margins turn a bold magenta hue. Consider this elegant tree for a dramatic entry planting in full sun, or light shade.

Size: 8 ft. tall and 3 ft. wide in 10 years.

SE MAPLE

Kawa Yatsubusa grow closely together and producing a dense leaf cover. New foliage, turns medium green as it matures. In fall, a wonderfully dramatic view.



The National Garden Bureau Declares 2025 YEAR OF THE CALADIUM

If you've never enjoyed *Caladiums* before, then make 2025 the year to give these a try. We're absolutely sure you won't be disappointed. (*Caladiums* were the Number One most viewed video on the NGB web site in 2024, with more than half a million views).

Caladiums are a heat-loving annual that require dappled sunlight for the best colorations. They're a low-maintenance choice, only needing moderate watering and fertilizer with well-drained soil. There are so many cool patterns and leaf colors to choose from, your design options are limited only by your imagination!

In the wild, these plants are native to tropical forests in South America, where they thrive in high heat and humidity. European horticulturists have been cultivating them for their striking foliage since the 1700s.

Then a German plant breeder introduced them to us at *The Chicago Worlds Fair* in 1893. By the 1940's, Florida then became the *Caladium*-growing capital, where 90% of the world's production comes from.

You should also know, there's two kinds of *Caladiums*: strap leaf and fancy leaf. Strap leaf are more compact and have ruffled edges and can have better sun tolerance than fancy leaves. Fancy's are known for their heart-shaped leaves, and they also grow taller than the strap leaves.

Tubers (dormant roots) are available in the store now, and locally-grown plants will be in our greenhouse starting in mid-May. We look forward to you discovering *Caladiums*.

Some of our favorites are: in the *Heart to Heart* Series: *Heart and Soul*, *Splash of Wine*, *Tickle Me Pink*, *White Wonder*, *Scarlet Flame*, and *June Bride*. We can't imagine our summers without these both softening and dressing up our annual containers!

Fun Hummingbird Facts:

- Hummingbirds are the smallest migratory bird in the world
- They must eat all day long to survive
- They weigh the same as a nickel
- They fly at 60 mph forwards, and 33 mph backwards
- Their hearts beat 1,200 times per minute while flying (that's 6 beats per second!)
- They feed roughly every 10 minutes, and visit at least 1,000 flowers daily

We saw hundreds of new plant varieties growing in the sunny, hot Denver climate, all lovingly tended to by the students. Because it was *The Trials*, we got to vote, and filled out ballots, voting for our favorites. Of course, we ordered our favorites that stood out in the crowd, and are growing them in our greenhouses to become your favorites too! So what did we get?

NEW! ANNUAL for 2025 - Tanami Salvia

Whether it's attracting pollinators, or just flowering like crazy, this new *Salvia* series provides color all season long. Its heat and drought-tolerance might make it the perfect summer patio plant. Our *Beaver Bark* greenhouses are growing **blue, purple, red, rose, salmon, and white.**

NEW! PERENNIAL for 2025 Pink Pearl Agastache

Maturing quickly in the garden to 18" tall and 3' wide, this very fragrant, pollen-rich perennial is topped with a dense mat of extra-large, tubular pink flowers, starting mid May, blooming through September. This new breeding breakthrough is not to be missed if you have a well-drained, sunny spot to showcase them. Available for planting in early June. You're encouraged to reserve yours now, as quantities for this year are very limited.

A RETURNING FAVORITE Hummingbird's Lunch Cuphea

These nonstop tubular blooms ring the lunch bell for all the hummingbirds in the neighborhood. Very adaptive to hot summers with a tidy, rounded habit, this *Cuphea* is perfect in mixed containers or garden beds. It grows up to two feet tall! We are also growing other varieties, so you can whip up a very tempting smorgasbord for our hungry friends!

In addition to its catchy name, the lime green chartreuse leaves are eye-catching in the landscape, with clusters of lavender blue flowers above. It will continue to flower all summer long, without cutting back.

Drought-tolerant and winter hardy to -30° , it's a super easy, sun-loving perennial, and pollinators flock to it.

Maturing to only one foot tall and wide, it shines in mass plantings!

Did You Know?

Nepeta is also known as Catmint. Cats love catmint because it contains nepetalactone, an essential oil that stimulates their opioid system and releases endorphins. This can cause cats to become relaxed, playful, and even euphoric.

Peppermint and Spearmint

Imagine stepping outside and plucking a handful of fresh and fragrant mint leaves for a loved recipe or mixing into a soothing tea. Mint is so easy to grow, but should stay contained in a pot.

Mint is not only tasty, its medicinal properties can aid digestion, ease stress, and refresh your skin.

Growing a variety of mints gives you choices you never knew you needed, and we're growing the ones that make recipes shine.

MOJITO COCKTAIL MINT

Originally from Cuba, this is reputed to be the mint that tastes best for the perfect mojito. Very aromatic with sweet undertones. It also happens to be our favorite for that drink. Let's muddle together! We have an amazing selection of pottery to keep your mint contained.

THAI MINT

Aromatic leaves have a hint of caraway. Purple flowers.

CHOCOLATE MINT

A hint of chocolate is there, and is strong enough to make us love it.

ORANGE MINT

Tends to be stronger than many other mints, with a citrus/spice flavor.

PINEAPPLE MINT

Deliciously sweet and tropical, and a beauty in the garden with its foliage.

HOW TO MAKE a REFRESHING MINT MOJITO

Rum: Use white rum to keep this cocktail light.

Mint: Muddled fresh mint makes the cocktail extra-cooling and light.

Lime: Freshly-squeezed lime juice ensures a perfectly balanced cocktail. Keep slices for garnish.

Simple syrup: This homemade ingredient adds a delicate sweetness.

Carbonated water, seltzer or club soda: Top off the drink with some bubbles.

1. Gently muddle your fresh mint leaves in a cocktail shaker.
2. In the cocktail shaker, add lime juice, white rum, and simple syrup. Fill with ice, seal, and shake until very frosty.
3. Strain and enjoy. Fill a cocktail glass with fresh mint leaves and crushed ice. Pour the cocktail through a fine-mesh strainer, top with bubbly water of choice, and garnish with a lime slice.

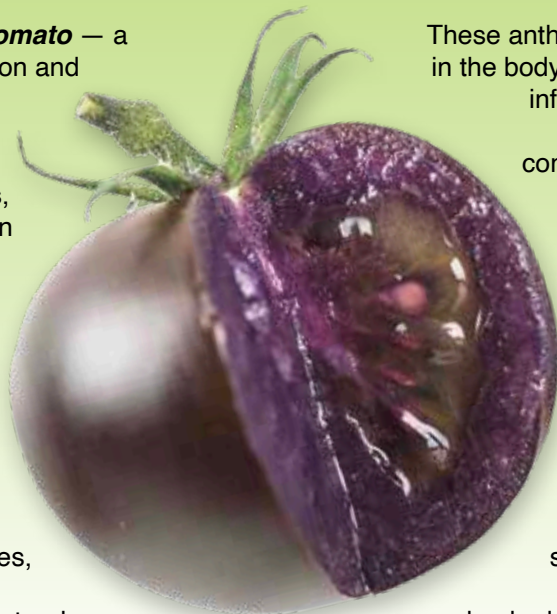

Planting them in a container as the **Spiller** plant is a fun way to grab a snack around the patio, (with the bonus of a high dose of Vitamin C).

Next is **Hatch** green chili; a product made famous from the high desert in New Mexico. They offer a fleshy pepper with a smoky flavor and a sneak up on you mild heat. Excellent for roasting and other green chili sauces.

They then grew these peppers for their family, saving more seeds year after year, as tradition dictates. When they died, their son Jimmy kept cultivating peppers, and saving seeds. Luckily, before passing away in the 1980s,

Jimmy donated some to the *Seed Savers Exchange*, who named the heirloom variety after him: *Jimmy Nardello's Pepper*. We hope you love this tasty pepper as much as we do! Grazie, Jimmy!

NEWPORT HYDRANGEA

One of our absolute favorites from the Seaside Serenade series

This is the showiest mophead rebloomer we've seen, in the most brilliant sapphire blue, and it makes a gorgeous cut flower in arrangements during the summer months. An acidic soil pH is required to keep these blue-violet colored flowers, and is very easy to do with amendments and soil acidifiers. Survives in Zones 4-9, a very cold-hardy variety, making it an outstanding shrub for a container. As with most other hydrangeas, it should not be planted out in the full sun of our summers, but will thrive in partial shade, maturing at three to four feet tall.

FRAGRANT DAPHNE

Daphnes are known for their *extremely intoxicatingly fragrant* flowers, and are a plant no yard should be without. Though there are many varieties, all have the same lovely scent, with the main difference being leaf color and size at maturity. Daphnes prefer well-drained soil, and some dappled shade. My own Daphne has been in the ground for 25 years in full sun here in the Tri-Cities, but is well-drained, and benefits from good, consistent watering habits.

First in the line-up is **SUMMER ICE** Fuss-free, giving you a flush of pink flowers spring through fall. The ivory tips on the foliage gives it a variegated look. Plant near a walkway, patio, or open window and breathe in the heavenly aroma. It tops out at three to four feet tall and wide.

Second in the line-up is **MOON CANYON** White flowers adorn the bold variegated leaves of this compact variety maturing to only two feet tall and wide.

Third in the line-up is **JIM'S PRIDE** This is an all-time favorite, as it has a long bloom time to enjoy the champagne-white, intensely fragrant flowers, even through November. At full maturity, *Jim's Pride* will reach four feet tall, and six feet wide.

Fourthly in the line-up is **ETERNAL FRAGRANCE** A tidy shrub that remains evergreen if temperatures stay above zero. Slow growing to two to three feet tall and wide. Full Blooms of white and pink flowers in spring followed by repeated light flowering through the fall are a bit larger than other varieties. The foliage is all green.



Newport hydrangea will give you more blues when it gets acid supplementation. This pH change makes the blooms blue, and really pops the color. Science for the win!
